

ACC Standards for Alternative Pool Fencing

The objective of outlining these standards is to provide guidelines to homeowners anticipating the installation of pool fencing other than the screened in patio or pool enclosures. Fencing will be permitted in lieu of a screen enclosure if approved by the ACC and must meet the following conditions:

- Must be attached to the deck area and follow the perimeter footprint of a typical screen enclosure**
- Fencing shall be of suitable, quality material such as wrought iron or aluminum and decorative in nature**
- Opaque fencing will not be allowed, such as stockade type fencing**
- Landscaping guidelines for alternative pool fencing will follow those outlined in the homeowners' documents for screen enclosures**
- Fencing must meet all County and other applicable codes**
