

ACC Standards for Basketball Hoops

- All references listed are concerning the semi-permanent placement of portable basketball hoops on residential property.
- All hoops shall be portable to the extent that they could be easily taken down and stored in the event of a storm, hurricane or dangerous winds.
- All hoops shall be properly tied down and/or secured for the safety of all residents.
- All hoops shall be placed to the inside of an existing driveway not farther than the top third between the home and the street.
- All hoops shall be the standard height (10') or shorter.
- All hoops shall be kept in good repair.
- All hoops shall have black, white, silver or dark green poles and bases that can be integrated into the landscaping.
- All hoops shall be landscaped to blend into the existing landscape and to shield the view of the hoop as much as possible.
- Detailed landscaping plan must be submitted with hoop request.
- Homeowner assumes liability of damage caused by hoop or its use.
- Hours of use will be limited from sun-up to sundown.
- Permission for a hoop is non-transferable.
- Location must not cause interference, visual or trespass, to adjacent properties.
- Must have approved sign off by neighbors within 200 feet.
- Must be approved by the ACC.
